## Notes on the installation of R and 'astrochron'

These notes provide information on how to download and install the R software, and the R package 'astrochron'. It is important to have the latest version of R, so please upgrade if you have an older version.

- (I) Download R from <a href="http://www.r-project.org">http://www.r-project.org</a>
  - Select a CRAN mirror site, then you will come to the download page.
  - Download the most recent 'precompiled binary' (top of the webpage)

NOTE: for Windows, this binary will be located in the directory 'base'

- (2) Click on the downloaded file to install, and follow the instructions. When installing, use all defaults.
- (3) Start R by clicking on the R icon.
- (4) Install the 'astrochron' library.

## For MAC:

- · Go to 'Packages & Data' menu, then 'Package Installer'
- Choose 'Cran (binaries)'
- Click 'Get List', then choose a mirror
- Under 'Package Search' type 'astrochron'
- Install 'At System Level (in R framework)
- Click on 'Install Dependencies'
- Then click 'Install Selected'

## For Windows:

- Go to 'Packages', then 'Install Package(s)'
- Choose your CRAN mirror
- · Find and install package 'astrochron'
- Also find and install packages 'multitaper', 'IDPmisc', 'fields', 'doParallel', 'iterators' and 'foreach' (if they aren't automatically installed)
- (5) You'll need to load the 'astrochron' package each time you restart R. Load the 'astrochron' package by typing:

library(astrochron)

(6) To see what's inside the 'astrochron' package type: ?astrochron
