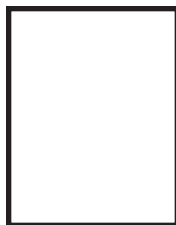

PACROFI VII will be held on the campus of the University of Nevada, Las Vegas (UNLV) on June 1- 4, 1998. A reception is scheduled the evening of June 1.
